The Outdoor Learning Program at LECS is an ALL WEATHER program.

Children are learning about how to dress smartly for different types of weather. Children will need to dress for ALL WEATHER every day so that they are prepared to work hard and play hard outside. Thank you for helping them to be ready. This is especially important in winter. Children should have warm clothing ready to be outside. As part of our school uniform, you may purchase polar fleece tops and beanies at Front Office.

Children attending our school in preschool to year 2 are expected to come dressed in school uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school and when engaged in school activities out of school (this includes school excursions).

The school uniform is available for purchase at Front Office. It includes shirts in school colours and blue bucket hats.

The school uniform reflects a child's sense of belonging to our school. It also sets community standards and is consistent with occupational health and safety, anti-discrimination, equal opportunity legislation and the Education Directorate's Sun Protection policy.
