# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

#### **LOOSE PARTS PLAY**

Loose Parts Play is a significant component of the teaching and learning program at LECS. You will hear from your child about the excitement and challenge of engaging with the large variety of materials on offer. Loose Parts Play is a highly intentional learning time. Children are intentionally taught the dispositions of collaboration, commitment, craftsmanship, curiosity, communication, compassion, confidence and creativity in multiple ways. The Australian Curriculum and Early Years Learning Framework are also taught through Loose Parts Play. For example, the kindergarten children used Loose Parts across a number of weeks last term to experiment with force and motion as part of the science curriculum. A typical session begins with a group introduction to the learning intention, then the teacher prompts discussion and action around the learning intention as children use Loose Parts. The session ends with a group reflection.





If your child comes home and talks about Loose Parts Play have a discussion about not only what they did, but what they learnt from engaging in the play.

Whilst the frosty winter has arrived, your P&C has been brain-storming how we can be the P&C you need!


